Being produced by the co-extrusion method this sheet is very rigid and provides increased impact strength. With its extensive shades of white and – as VEKAPLAN Wood – the various wood grain and single-colour foils, it is the ideal sheet for door panels for both interior and exterior use.

- thermo- and vacuum-forming
- sawing, milling, drilling
- cutting, punching
- adhesive bonding


